About the 1861 Club

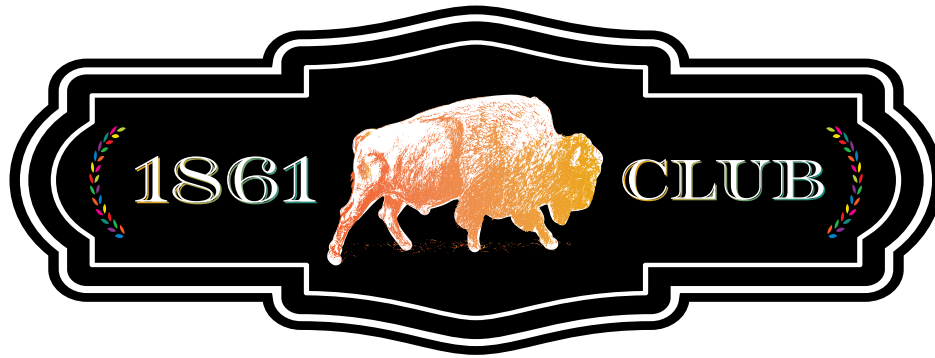
